

Kabrda, Josef /1906 - 1968 Ankara/ Prof. at the Philosophical faculty of the J.E. Purkyně University in Brno. Studied in Prague, Paris and Sofia. Historian of the Ottoman Turkey and the Balkans, is specially studying problems related to the publication kannnames from the period Ottoman expansion of the Balkan and Slovakia. He collected Ottoman documents which are of special importance for the history of the Orthodox Church under the Ottoman Empire. Published materials for the history of Franco-Ottoman relation at the time of Napoleon I, and for economy and administration of some Balcan provinces of Empire.
