The periodical will also touch on many points in the history of the Slavic world, Byzantium, Iran, the Caucasus, the lands of Islam and the peoples of Central and Northern Europe, as well as elucidate various questions of Turkic and steppe history.

Authors of articles will receive twenty-five free offprints of their contribution and a free copy of the volume in which their article appears.
