i (2017) pp. 195-238. Oluf Gerhard Tychsen
(1734-1815) studied at the pietistic *Institutum*
Judaicum et Muhammedicum in Halle. He showed
great interest in Jewish studies and took part in
missionary activities throughout Germany. As a
teacher of oriental studies at the universities of
Bützow and later of Rostock he was in charge of an
academic network with about 200 correspondents
from all parts of Europe. Besides his numismatic and
linguistic expertise he was deeply occupied with the
"Jewish question". The paper explores how Tychsen's
activities in these fields were interwoven with the
Jewish striving for emancipation against the
background of Haskala and Pietism.
